



Our aim in creating this design is to improve play facilities, address crime, provide space for community events and cater for all ages, abilities and cultural backgrounds.

Through discussions with the working group we have come up with the theme of **exploration**. Many of the roads which make up the Harringay Ladder are named after explorers and the area is now so rich in diversity we thought this would create an interesting focal point. Much of the play equipment has a nautical theme and the central compass provides a space for local events.

Please be aware that funding for this project has not yet been secured and will be sought when we have a final design. In the case that not all necessary funding is available it is crucial we know your priorities for the open space.
