

Who can apply?

- Local residents
- Community groups working within a specified neighbourhood
- Ward councillors

How to apply?

Complete the freepost tear-off slip attached to this leaflet providing a brief description of the proposed project and its positive impact on the neighbourhood. The Making the Difference budget is for one-off projects with no long-term commitments.

Each project can be awarded a maximum of £10,000.

Who decides?

The Area Assembly chairs, who are also ward councillors, make the final decision on successful projects after consultation with residents and council officers.

What can be funded?

- One off projects that make a significant improvement to a neighbourhood or to residents living in that neighbourhood
- Projects that can be completed within the financial year 2008/2009
- Projects need to be sustainable (particularly environmental projects)
