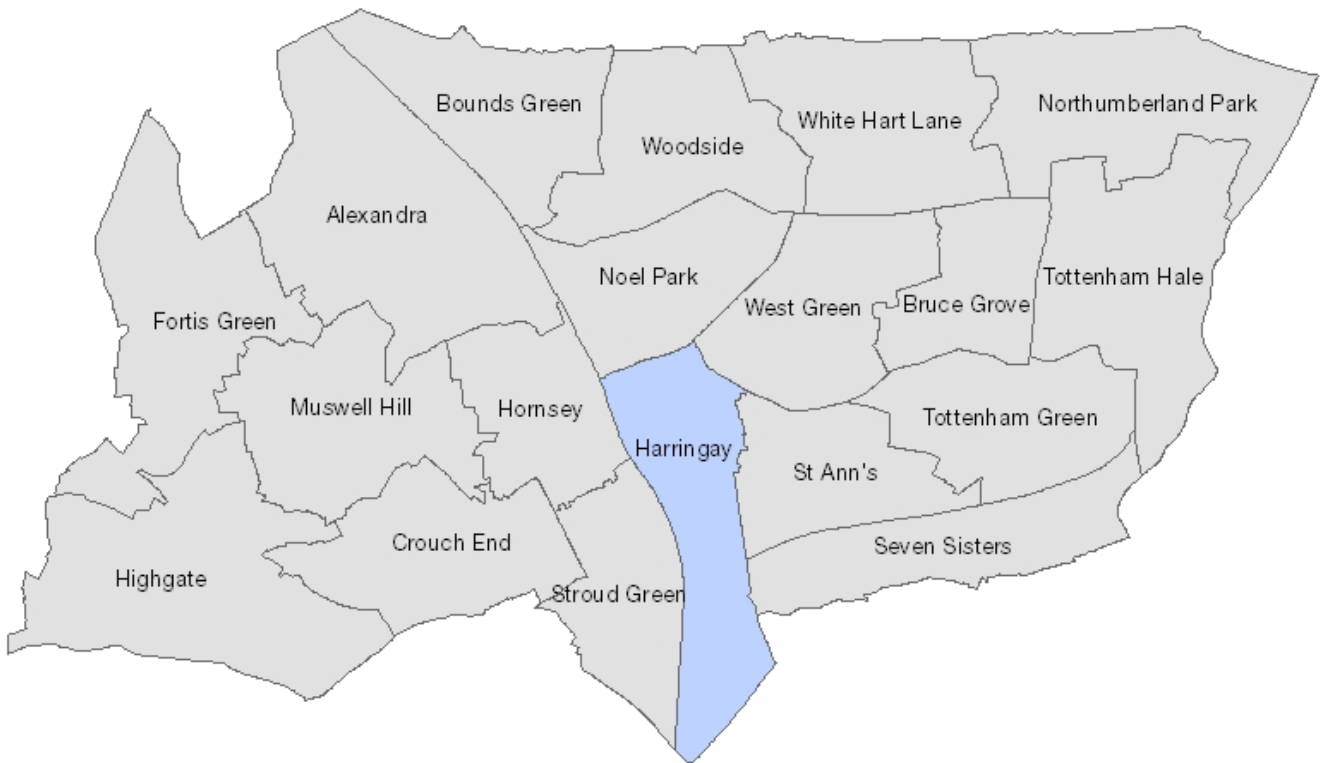


# HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: HARRINGAY

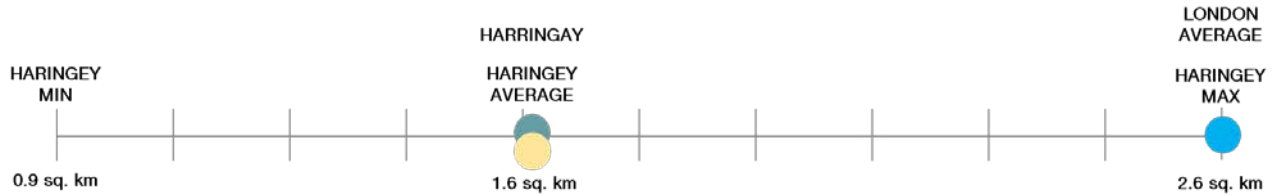

# HARRINGAY ATTRIBUTES

## SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), HARRINGAY

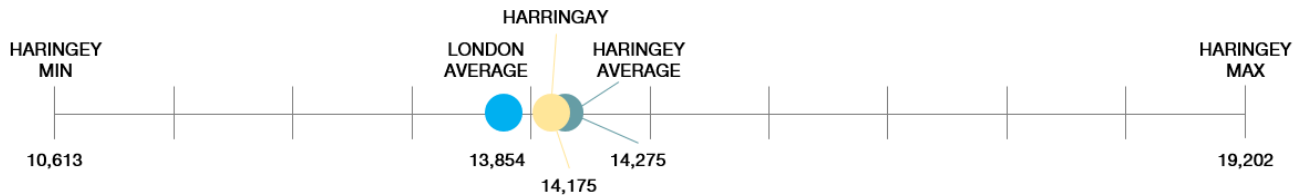
- At 1.9 sq. km, Harringay is in line with the Haringey average (1.6 sq. km), but smaller than the size of the average London ward (2.6 sq. km).

## POPULATION, HARRINGAY

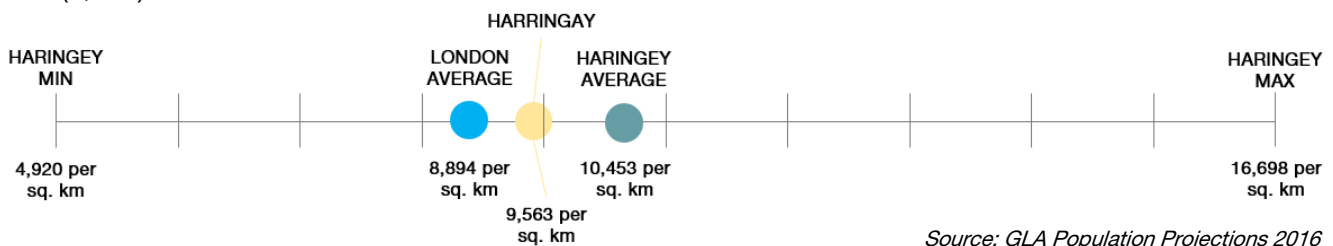
- At 14,175 people, the population of Harringay is in line with the borough average. This is slightly larger than the average London ward (13,854).

## POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), HARRINGAY

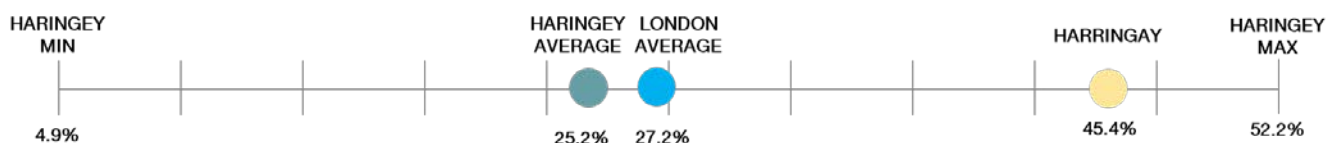
- Population density in Harringay is slightly lower than the Haringey average, at 9,563 residents per sq. km (compared to a borough average of 10,453). This is slightly higher than the London average (8,894).

## OPEN SPACE, HARRINGAY

- 45.4% of Harringay ward is made up of open space, above the Haringey (25.2%) and London (27.2%) averages.
- Harringay has the second largest proportion of open space of all Haringey wards.

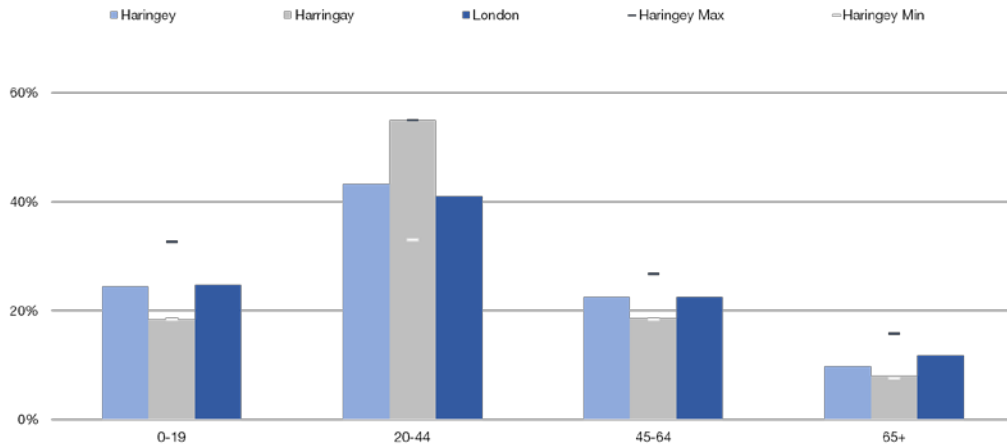

# DEMOGRAPHICS

## POPULATION AGE, HARRINGAY

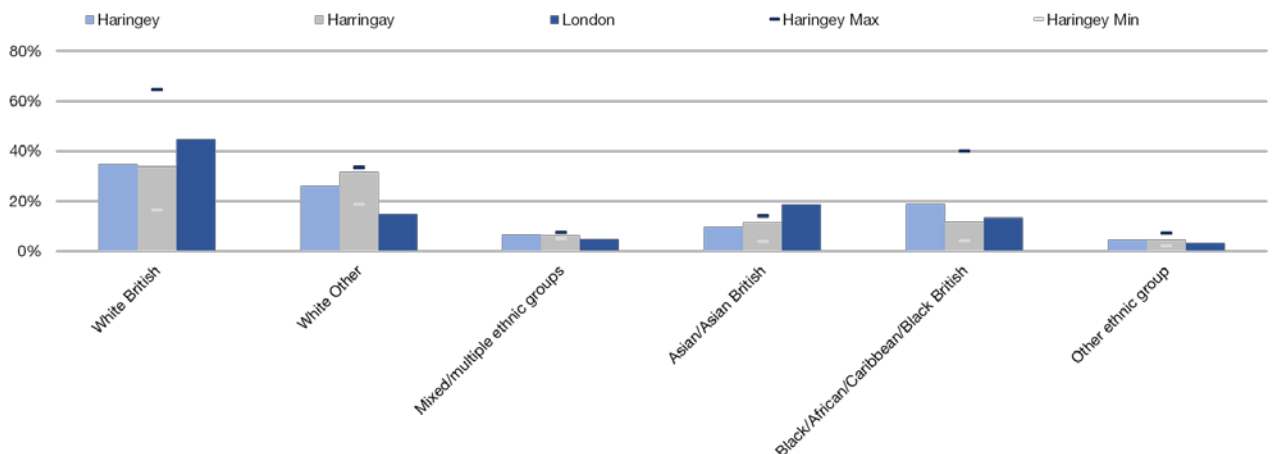
- Harringay's overall population spread mirrors that seen in Haringey more widely, with those aged 20-44 making up the largest proportion of residents (55%, the largest proportion in the borough), and those aged 65+ making up the smallest proportion (8%).
- While following the wider borough pattern, the 20-44 age group is much more prominent in Harringay than the wider borough average. By contrast, the ward has among the smallest proportions of 0-19 year olds, 45-59 year olds and 65+ year olds of all Haringey wards.

## ETHNICITY, HARRINGAY

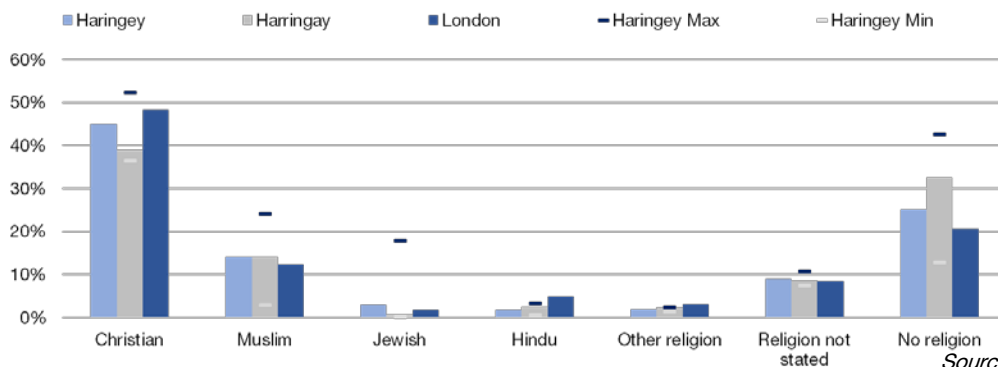
- In Harringay there is a slightly larger proportion of residents of White Other ethnicity (31.7%) compared to the Haringey average (25.9%), and a slightly smaller proportion of residents of Black ethnicity (11.8%) compared to the borough average (18.8%).

## RELIGION, HARRINGAY

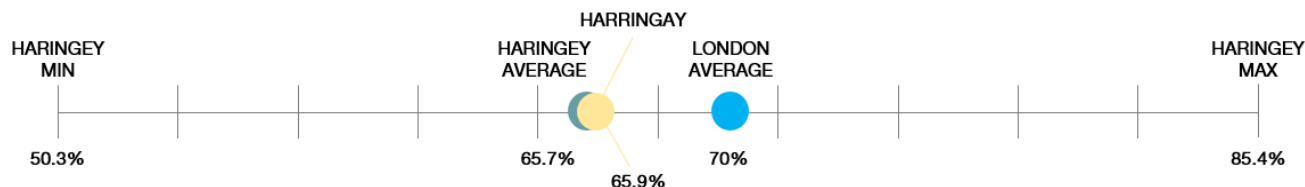
- Harringay has a larger proportion of residents identifying as having no religion (32.7%), compared to the wider borough (25.2%).
- The ward also has a smaller proportion of residents identifying as Christian (39%) than is seen across Haringey (45%).



## EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

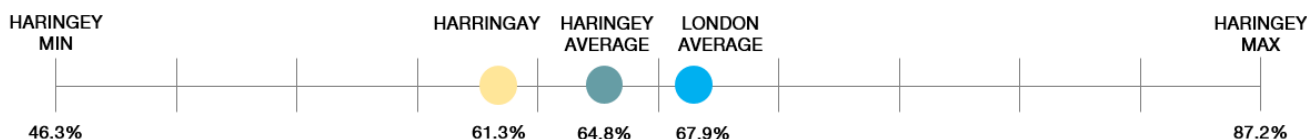
### % PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, HARRINGAY

- In Harringay the proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level (65.9%) is in line with the average in Haringey (65.7%). Both Harringay and the borough as a whole are slightly below London (70%).



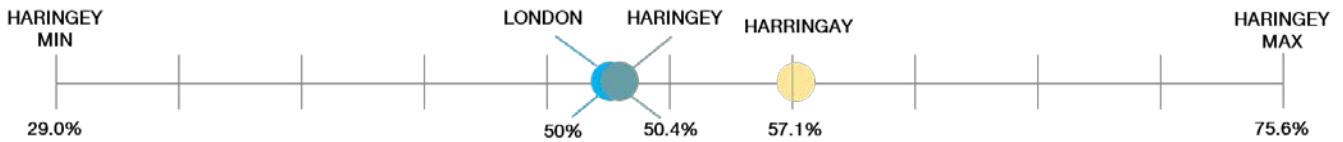
### % PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, HARRINGAY

- In Harringay, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (61.3%) is below the Haringey and London averages (64.8% and 67.9% respectively).
- There is substantial variation in GCSE attainment among different Haringey wards, ranging from 46.3% achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths, to 87.2%.



## % QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, HARRINGAY

- In Haringay, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (57.1%) is above the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

## INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

### MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, HARRINGAY

- The median household income in Haringay is £37,150 a year. This is in line with the Haringey (£37,696) average, and slightly below the London (£39,264) average.

### UNEMPLOYMENT, HARRINGAY

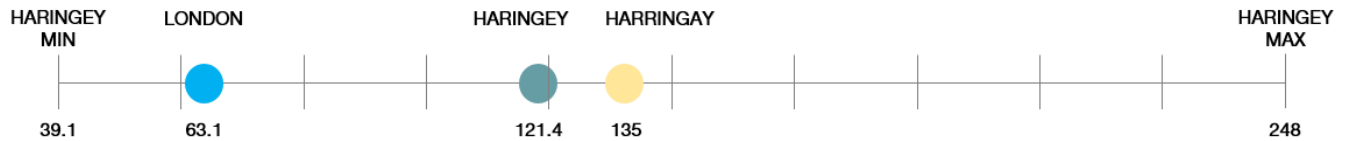
- 7.2% of Haringay residents are unemployed. This is below the Haringey (8.6%) average, but in line with the London (7.3%) average.

## JSA CLAIMANTS, HARRINGAY

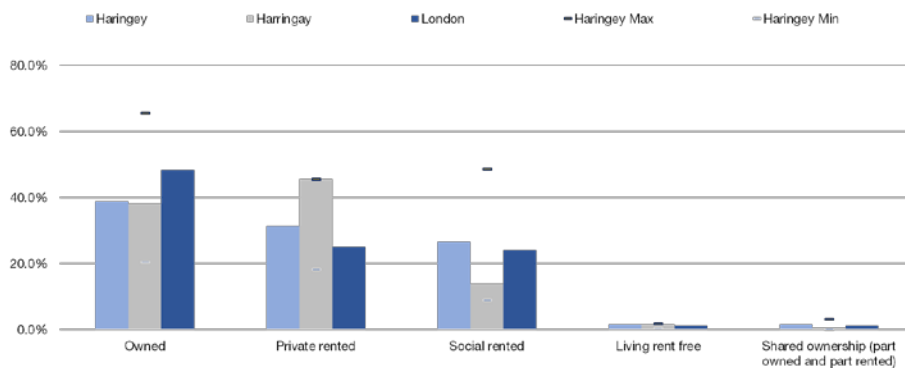
- In Haringey there are 135 JSA claimants for every 10,000 residents.
- This is substantially higher than the London rate (63.1 per 10,000 residents), and while it is slightly higher than the Haringey level (121.4) it is not among the highest levels in the borough.
- The rate of JSA claimants in Haringey is almost double the London rate.

## HOUSING TENURE, HARRINGAY

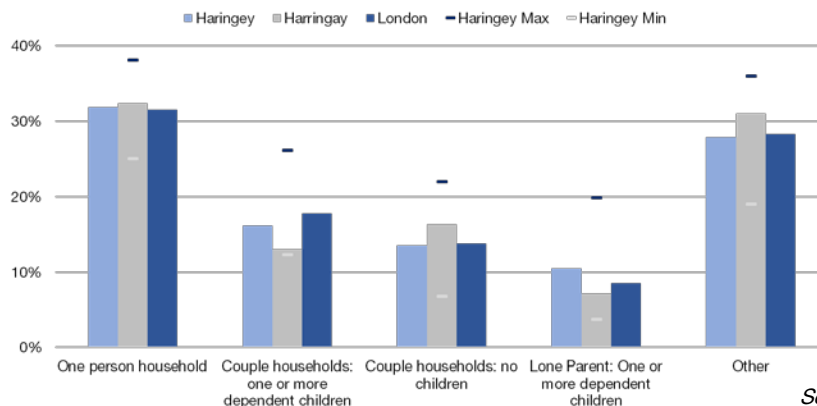
- Haringay households are most likely be privately rented (45.6%). This is the largest proportion of all Haringey wards.
- By contrast, social renting is less common in Haringay, representing 13.9% of all households in the ward (compared to 26.7% in the borough more widely).

## HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, HARRINGAY

- In Haringay, Couple households that have one or more dependent children (13%) are slightly less common than in Haringey (16%), as are Lone parent households with one or more dependent children (7.2% vs. 10.5% in the wider borough).

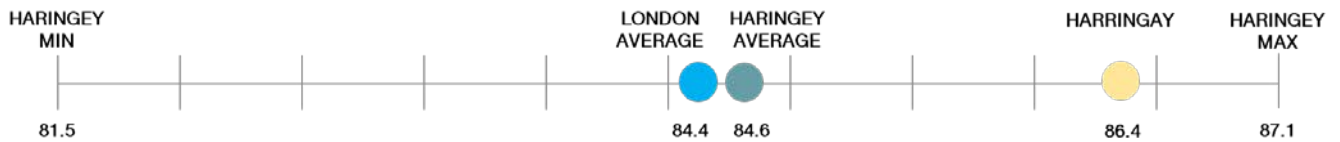

# HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

## FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, HARRINGAY

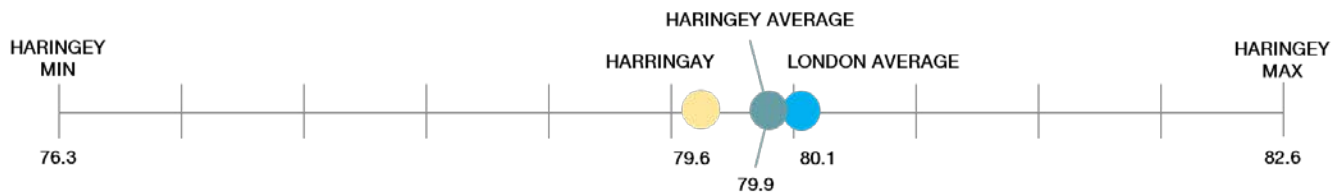
- Female life expectancy in Haringay is 86.4 years, substantially higher than the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages. This is the third highest female life expectancy of all Haringey wards.

## MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, HARRINGAY

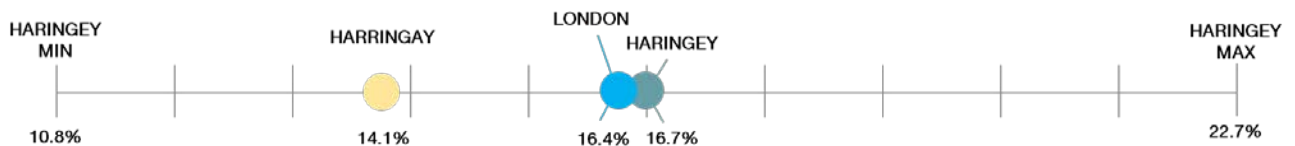
- Male life expectancy in Haringay is 79.6 years, slightly lower than the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages.

## RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, HARRINGAY

- In Haringay 14.1% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is below the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely.

% PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, HARRINGAY

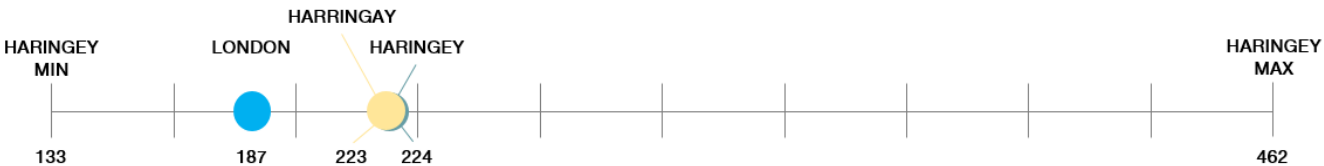
- 41.6% of Year 6 children in Harringay have excess weight. This is higher than the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages but is not amongst the highest levels in the borough.

RATE OF CRIME, HARRINGAY

- In Harringay there were 223 crimes per 1,000 residents between February 2017 and January 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was in line with the Haringey rate and higher than London (224 per 1,000 residents and 187 per 1,000 residents respectively).
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 19% above the London rate.
