

Power Up is a weekend of workshops and networking to empower people to make a difference.

Find out how to use the system effectively to improve your environment and find out about how proposed changes to the planning system may affect your community.

Learn how to confidently use legal and planning knowledge and share your ideas with others. Gain the tools, confidence and contacts to help make your community a cleaner, healthier, fairer place to live. You will leave feeling inspired, energised and well connected, ready to apply your new skills to your important local issues.

You don't need to be an expert, but you will be active and keen to make a difference. Power Up is particularly for people working in disadvantaged areas and with groups whose voices are not usually heard in decision making. If you're already involved in a local campaign and you want to make sure you are using your rights effectively, then Power Up is for you.
