

A TASTE OF WHAT IS HAPPENING

Music – all types – from classical to children's bands, Indie Rock, Choral, Jazz, Soul, Folk, Rock and even Vocal Tai Chi. Performances will be all over Crouch End & Hornsey – the main stage will be in front of the town hall plus gigs at the Music Palace, churches, local pubs and cafes.

Craft Trail – over 36 stalls showing mosaic, hat making, jewellery, greeting cards and textiles and much, much more, at various locations including outside Oddbins, Budgens, Monkey Nuts, Nest and the Library.

Visual Arts – including contemporary and fine art, illustration and photography displayed all over Crouch End.

Workshops for adults and children, including Flamenco Dance, Salsa, story telling, wool making, script writing, art & crafts. Most will be at Hornsey Vale Community Centre.

Theatre with Crouch End Players in Priory Park. Plus 'She & Me', short plays outside the library involving the Huxley statue as a member of the cast.

Surprise Cinema (18+ only) – secret cinema on Sunday by the library. Introduced by Pete Bradshaw (Guardian film critic). Bring a late night picnic.

Talks – Lynda Grant (Orange Prize Winner, Booker nominee) speaking in the Library.

Poetry – in the library plus Poetry in a Phone Box by the green. Knock on the door or call for a poem.
Burlesque – Club 1830 – Saturday at the Music Palace.

Writing competition – "The Day Crouch End Stood Still" a science fantasy writing competition for kids and adults.

Invented Histories – local histories will be telling you fantasy tales of Crouch End.


Sunday School – showcasing the best of our young talent from local schools at the Music Palace.
