Endymion Road junction with Alroy Road: Pedestrian Accessibility Improvements

Dear Resident,

I am pleased to inform you that the Council will be introducing pedestrian and cycle accessibility improvements to the junction of Endymion Road and Alroy Road. This is in response to representations from the local community to improve conditions for pedestrians and cyclists who often experience difficulties when seeking to cross or access the junction.

The improvements will involve introducing a raised table at the existing roundabout and narrowing lanes where possible to slow traffic negotiating this junction. Full details are set out on the attached plan and consist of:

- Raised junction feature to improve awareness and visibility
- Small traffic islands to narrow the approach lanes (subject to review)
- New coloured paving pedestrian crossing points

This notification letter marks the start of a three week period during which we welcome all comments and representations using the enclosed Freepost feedback card.
