

**Wightman Road  
Bridge closure work  
Briefing update no. 3  
8<sup>th</sup> April 2016**

- A second set of adjustments have been made to the traffic signals at the Turnpike Lane/Green Lanes/High Road and we will continue to monitor this on a daily basis.
- An additional electronic variable message sign has been placed at the bottom of Muswell Hill in response to traffic congestion issues in Turnpike Lane/High Street N8.
- Monday morning (11<sup>th</sup> April) will inevitably see an increase in traffic with the start of the new school term. Officers will be on site over the coming week to monitor this.
- We will be undertaking further engagement with schools next week, including those in the affected areas of Islington and Hackney.
- Work is continuing as regards liaison with local businesses.
- The temporary footbridge on site at the rail bridge is now open to ensure continued pedestrian and cycle access between Endymion / Alroy Roads and Wightman Road.
