

Wightman Road Bridge closure work Briefing update no. 3 8th April 2016

- A second set of adjustments have been made to the traffic signals at the Turnpike Lane/Green Lanes/High Road and we will continue to monitor this on a daily basis.
- An additional electronic variable message sign has been placed at the bottom of Muswell Hill in response to traffic congestion issues in Turnpike Lane/High Street N8.
- Monday morning (11th April) will inevitably see an increase in traffic with the start of the new school term. Officers will be on site over the coming week to monitor this.
- We will be undertaking further engagement with schools next week, including those in the affected areas of Islington and Hackney.
- Work is continuing as regards liaison with local businesses.
- The temporary footbridge on site at the rail bridge is now open to ensure continued pedestrian and cycle access between Endymion / Alroy Roads and Wightman Road.
