

# Wightman Road Bridge closure work Briefing update no. 4 15<sup>th</sup> April 2016

- Daily monitoring of traffic and dynamic adjustment of junction signals by Transport for London (TfL) to improve traffic flows.
- There was an increase in traffic on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2016, when schools resumed for the new school term. However congestion levels were lower than anticipated.
- Schools have reported that apart from minor disruption on the first day of the new term, the road closure is not impacting on the operation of schools in the area.
- Officers were on site over the week to monitor traffic and offer assistance where needed.
- Following the opening of the temporary footbridge over the railway lines, additional physical measures were installed to improve pedestrian safety, deterring misuse by cyclists and moped riders.
