

## Wightman Road Bridge closure work Briefing update no.11 17 June 2016

- Signs have been installed providing access guidance to the businesses on Wightman Road.



- The concrete barriers used in enforcing the road closure on Sydney Road will be re-positioned by Monday 20 June to ensure adequate gap is maintained between the barriers for emergency access whilst also preventing vehicles from overrunning the adjacent footways to exit on to Wightman Road and vice versa.
- As part of the rail bridge replacement works, Network Rail will be carrying out nights works on the following weekends:
  - **25 and 26 June** – Removal of Bridge Parapet and Beam
  - **2 and 3 July** – Delivery and Installation of Steel Bridge Beam Sections and crash Deck. To facilitate the safe transport of the

Bridge Beam Sections to the works site, we will be temporarily suspending some parking bays along the access routes for the delivery vehicle. We would request that you do not park in the suspended bays as it may lead to your vehicle being removed and potential delays to the works programme

- **9 and 10 July** – Installation of Permanent and Temporary Formworks and Steel reinforcement for bridge deck
- **16 and 17 July** – Concrete Pour to Bridge Deck
- **23 and 24 July** – Concrete Pour or Bridge Parapets
- **20 and 21 August** – Removal of scaffold, walkway and installation of Pigeon Spikes and netting and Pilaster Capping Stones.

We will endeavor to keep the noise generated from these activities to the bare minimum.
