Bikehangar Cycle Parking in Your Road

Encouraging more people to cycle is an important part of central Government and Haringey Council policy to tackle traffic congestion, improve air quality, promote physical activity and improve accessibility.

Our commitment includes promoting cycling as a serious transport alternative, and with the continuing growth in numbers of people who cycle we recognise the need for safe and secure cycle parking.



We want to help residents without adequate cycle storage space by offering a Bikehangar facility in which space can be rented.

Bikehangars are communal bike lockers with space for six bicycles. Each Bikehangar unit occupies less than one car parking space.

The units are easy to open as they have selflifting doors, and the steel design protects cycles from vandalism and wet weather. Local residents can rent a Bikehangar space by paying a small annual fee and key deposit to 'Cyclehoops'. The Bikehangar is initially installed on a temporary basis. If successful it will be made permanent – with additional amenity features such as bollards or trees currently being considered, subject to funding availability.

To date we have installed four Bikehangars in the borough and all the cycle parking spaces were rented out within a week.

Following requests from residents, we propose installing a Bikehangar in your road. The proposed locations are listed overleaf in road name order.

In view of the summer holiday season, we are extending the consultation period until 4 September 2015. If no major objections are received we plan to install the Bikehangar before the end of September.
